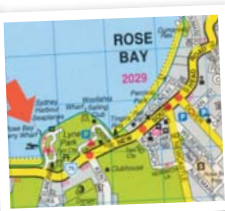

# Most Popular Sydney Dive Sites

<b>Long Reef: 'The Wall'/'Apartments'</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 25m</li> </ul>	<p>There are many good dives along this wall running north/south, 'The APARTMENTS' might just be the 'fishiest' dive in Sydney. You'll find soft coral, sponges, and a variety of fish; rarer species hide in the crevices along 'The Wall'.</p>
<b>Dee Why:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Openwater &amp; AOW</li> <li>- Max. depth: 30+m</li> </ul>	<p>An extensive reef system off the northern beaches which drops to 30m, thus considered an AOW+ dive. Discover a variety of fish, sponge gardens, pelagics . . .</p>
<b>Magic Point:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 25m</li> </ul>	<p>Magic point, our most popular dive-site! Located off south Maroubra Beach, it's the location of Sydney's Grey Nurse shark Population. Fearsome-looking yet placid creatures, the shark dive is exhilarating! The shark cave lays in 16m of water; the outlying area is worth exploration!</p>
<b>Wedding Cake :</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 25m</li> </ul>	<p>A small located off Coogee on Sydney's southern coast. An interesting dive that has many nooks and crannies to explore.</p>
<b>Manly Bommie</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 25m</li> </ul>	<p>A great reef to explore! Pelagic encounters, cuttlefish, Port Jackson sharks, nudies . . .</p>
<b>Blue Fish Wall + 'Runway 36'</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 25m</li> </ul>	<p>Sea dragons, blue wrasse, lionfish, and Weedy Seadragons can be found among the boulders, drop-offs, and kelp. Explore the wall at Blue Fish for interesting macro stuff. 'Runway 36' is a reef located out on the sand where all sorts of fishlife and macro-life occurs!</p>
<b>Barren's Hut</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water/AOW</li> <li>- Max. depth: 28m</li> </ul>	<p>Considered one of the best boat dives in the Sydney area, located only a few hundred metres off Royal National Park and has everything a diver wants in a site; definitely one of the top five reef dive sites in NSW. Dramatic drop-offs and rock platforms: depths of 12 to 28 metres. 'Amphitheatres' and 'caves'. The walls at the drop-off are completely covered with a huge abundance of fishlife: blue groper and wrasse. Usually blessed with relatively clear water: on average 15 metres. FISH! Usually countless amounts: Blue gropers and huge schools of yellowtail with enormous yellowtail kingfish; one-spot pullers and ladder-finned pomfrets; further out on the sand: Baird's solitary coral, Gabo Island soft coral, southern and Zimmets sea fans and sometimes wandering anemones. A must dive!</p>
<b>North Head: 'Wall' + 'Old Man's Hat' + 'The Blocks'</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water/AOW</li> <li>- Max. depth: 28m</li> </ul>	<p>Numerous (mostly) sheltered sites extending from Quarantine Head, east along the base of North Head past Old Man's Hat, and on to The Blocks, has a diver swimming along an extensive underwater scree slope. You can see Wobegong Sharks, Cuttlefish, blue groper, octopus and nudibranch with swim-throughs and sponge gardens. Weedies amongst the kelp and even Ghost Pipefish can be found by the keen-eyed diver! The Blocks, named after the huge local boulders, have numerous swim-throughs with lots of macro life - 27m to the sand!</p>
<b>The Stack</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: OW+</li> <li>- Max. depth: 33m</li> </ul>	<p>A dive site not far from North Bondi, The Stack is named after the old sewerage vent located on the cliff-top. A great dive site that also allows for much exploration AMongst the reef's 'stepping' structure which drops from 12m to over 30m! Expect to see lots of cuttlefish. At the right time of year, huge schools of swirling, circling salmon will mezerize you!</p>
<b>SS Tuggerah</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Adv+</li> <li>- Max. depth: 48m</li> </ul>	<p>Location: ~2km east of Sydney's Royal National Park. Depth: 48m Brief: The ship, a coastal collier, was hit by a rogue wave (judged to be 6m in height) in 1919, which swamped the vessel and forced her over. She sank quickly with a loss of 6 lives. Rediscovered in 1972, she has been a popular, albeit deep, wreck dive since. Encounter: Fish: countless quantities of them from bullseyes, nannygais to yellowtail and usually envelope the wreck often to obscurity. The rare Stargazer might be seen and even the odd seal. An exciting dive requiring Deep Certification.</p>
<b>Barren's Hut</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 23m</li> </ul>	<p>The reef here runs to a maximum depth of 23m. The reef has a lot of small and large boulders as well as a sheer wall; depth to 16m in most locations. The boulders create a lot of swim-throughs and small caves. Some of the large boulders, covered in sponges, ascidians, sea squirts and small gorgonias, are as big as a room. Fish vary from black drummer, luderick, to blackfish and grouper, one-spot pullers, leather-jackets, and breAM. Huge schools of yellowtail kingfish are not uncommon!</p>
<b>Marley/Osbourne</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cert: Open Water</li> <li>- Max. depth: 23m</li> </ul>	<p>Located east of Cronulla in Sydney's south. Terrain for both sites similar: platform reefs from 12m to 20m with a cave at around 19m. Encounter: vast assortment of nudibranchs, blue groper, red morwong, common bullseye, stripey, mado, silver sweep, crimson-banded wrasse, maori wrasse, cuttlefish, sergeant baker, old wife, white ear, black reef leatherjacket, striped seapike, yellow-striped leatherjacket, Port Jackson sharks, one-spot puller, blue-striped goat-fish, yellowtail, pufferfish, the beautiful eastern blue devil, ladder-finned pomfret, serpent eel, dusky flatheads. Common stingarees can be seen on the sand with common sea-dragons near the rocks on the eastern side and west of the cave. High chance of pelagics.</p>
